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



A handsome, detached family house with extensive accommodation over three floors in a premium setting in the popular village of Bridge. On the ground floor the accommodation includes a large siting room with wood-burning stove and adjoining family room overlooking and opening onto the garden. There is an impressive kitchen/breakfast room, comprehensively fitted featuring solid granite work surfaces and a multi-oven range. The separate dining room has an elegant, vaulted ceiling and also opens onto the garden. There is a substantial reception hall and adjacent study, both of which have exposed parquet wood flooring. On the first floor are five bedrooms, the master having a well equipped en-suite bathroom. The family bathroom has a bath and separate large shower. There is an attractive partially galleried landing from which a further staircase leads to the second floor and bedroom six.

Location

The property is approached from the road by a long drive providing parking and access to the double garage. There is a large front lawn and a side path leading to the rear garden. The garden has a large paved seating area to the rear of the house with adjacent raised flower beds. Steps lead up to an expansive lawn with inset beds and mature borders stocked with a variety of small trees, shrubs, flowering and ground covering plants. To the rear is a gravelled vegetable garden with raised beds and a greenhouse. The garden is enclosed by wood panelled fencing, chain-link fencing and hedging. The garden has an average depth of 165ft (50.25m) and an average width of 80ft (24.37m).

The property is set in a highly regarded residential location in the thriving and popular village of Bridge with easy access to surrounding countryside which offers lovely walks and cycling. The village boasts a well-respected primary school and has a comprehensive range of amenities including mini-supermarket with post office, pharmacy and health centre and three pubs. May 2019 sees the opening of the new Pig Hotel at Bridge Place, a newly refurbished handsome 17th century manor house providing a wonderful boutique style hotel and restaurant in a delightful setting. Canterbury is easily accessible providing further facilities, high speed rail services to London and an impressive range of both state and independent schools.

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

Get to know your local authorities

Local government directly affects quality of life, particularly when it comes to council tax, planning, waste disposal and the impact of local policies. You may want to investigate how this is likely to affect you if you decide to move.

There are nearly 400 local authorities in England, with five different types of local government structure. These can be broadly divided into **single-tier** and **two-tier authorities**.

Single-tier authorities are **Metropolitan Authorities**, **London Boroughs** and **Unitary** or **Shire Authorities**. Two-tier authorities have both a **County Council**, and a **District Council** or **City Council**.

There are also around 10,000 parish and town councils, effectively creating an additional tier in some areas - mostly, but not exclusively, in rural areas. The National Association of Local Councils (NALC) represents and works on behalf of these community councils and is a useful contact point.




Become familiar with public transport links

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





How are local schools performing?

Key Stage 0	Marker / indicator - no legal definition
Key Stage 1	Fits broadly with the first stage of education, i.e. ages 5-7.
Key Stage 2	Fits the later stage of primary education, often known as junior schools, i.e. ages 8-11. This takes pupils up to the standardised break at age 11 after which pupils generally change schools and transfer to secondary education.
Key Stage 3	Secondary education split between key stages 3 and 4, with key stage 3 covering ages 11-13.
Key Stage 4	Key Stage 4 (ages 14-16) covers the two year period of study for GCSE level examinations.
Key Stage 5	Beyond key stage 4 is 16+ or Sixth Form provision, sometimes unofficially referred to as Key Stage 5.



Primary Progress Measures




